These clubs provide a platform for the child to engage in practical learning experiences, fostering curiosity, critical thinking, and a deeper understanding of various techniques through active participation and exploration.**

Students are actively participating in these hands-on experiential activities. These sessions are scheduled during school hours/per week and on one Saturday in a month. On the forthcoming **Saturday, 27<sup>th</sup> April 24** the students will have **bagless day dedicated to Vocational Learning in these clubs.**

Here is a quick overview of the required materials for each club.
